P. SUMMARY OF CONTRIBUTION TO KNOWLEDGE

The research of Dr. Akintunde has contributed immensely in the area of agricultural finance, agribusiness management, livestock economics, and gender analysis. He had made an effort on assessment of poultry disease management level and its effects on profit of poultry egg farmers in Southwestern Nigeria in his Ph.D thesis. The assessment of poultry disease management level in Nigeria is a novel research; therefore, his study has contributed to the knowledge in estimation of the level of poultry disease management in the Southwest geopolitical zone of Nigeria by exploring fuzzy logic model as analytical tool. Three (3) disease management dimensions and forty-two (42) attributes were identified in his study to estimate the level of poultry disease management. It was revealed that majority of poultry farmers operate on low level of disease management, quantity feed, stock size, and poultry disease management index had positive effect on profit.
