The medical research and training facility is comprised of 250 admission beds, 20 Clinical Departments, 5 non-Clinical Departments, Community Health Unit, Maternity and Neonatal Medicare, Research and Diagnostics Laboratories, 4 State-of-the-art operating theatres, cutting-edge diagnostic imaging inclusive of CT scan, MRI scanning facility, ultrasound scanning facility, X-ray and radiotherapy suites, modern digitised CATHLAB, Cardiac theatre and Ophthalmology suites, 2 units of modern Luminos dRF Max Fluoroscopy, 4 digitised delivery rooms, 36 Units of fully digitised Neonatal ICU and incubators, 9 units of modern digitised dialysis with specialised units for HIV+ and Hepatitis B+ patients, 16 ICUs, modern mortuary and restaurant.

(ii) FINANCIAL RESOURCES FROM THE PIONEER ADVANCEMENT BOARD

Attracted huge financial resources to Osun State University through sourcing and recruiting philanthropist into the maiden Advancement Board of Uniosun (February 25, 2016), who in turn generated veritable list of donors to the University.
