N. SUMMARY OF CONTRIBUTION TO KNOWLEDGE

I have made contributions in the area of urban and regional geography/planning & development, environment, transport, and population studies. My Master of Urban and Regional Planning (MURP) dissertation is in the area of urban environment. My research for the Masters of Urban and Regional Planning focused on solid wastes management in the city of Ibadan. The work essentially explored the relationships between Ibadan city spatial pattern and the management of solid wastes. In my PhD thesis I have used gender as a category of classification of urban population to study the spatial differences and variations in the involvement of women and men in urban man-made feature development (housing) as well as in the impacts of housing on women and men in the urban area. The study has implications on planning urban expansion and planning urban improvement. The research was supported by the Council for the Development of Social Science Research in Africa (CODESRIA) small grants for thesis writing. Gender has also been used as a category of classification of urban population to study urban transportation experience of women and men. The study has implication on transport services/planning, that is, not only to make transport services affordable, accessible, safe and appropriate, but also gender sensitive., including developing transportation planning models that capture gender differences in trip purpose, frequency, and distance travel, mode of transportation used and complexity of trip making. My works have been with particular interest in the interrelation of urban society, practice and space, that is, (urban) place, people and practice. I have investigated the link between social support/networks, urban condition and the physical well-being of the elderly. I have also investigated the spatial behavior and daily activities of the elderly in the urban area. I have also study gender and urban ethno-communal conflicts in Nigeria. Conflicts linked to ethnicity have led to significant loss of life and injuries in many countries, and become major elements in impoverishment, undermining human security and sustainable urban health/development. In this research I investigate the question of whether and how gender influences conflict in Nigeria: the case of Ife-Modakeke conflicts. The study has implication for sustainable peace in the Ife and Modakeke communities. The research was supported by grants from the Centre for Research on Inequality, Human Security and Ethnicity (CRISE), University of Oxford, United Kingdom. My current research is in the urban spatial diffusion, awareness and utilization of geographical information systems/remote sensing. I have investigated public servants/urban managers' awareness and utilization of geographical information systems/remote sensing. The study has implications towards enhancing urban managers' capacity development in geospatial technologies.
