## **P. SUMMARY OF CONTRIBUTION TO KNOWLEDGE:**

### **(Focus: Rural Sociology, Livelihood studies, Food Security, and Gender Studies)**

Dr. Alabi's research publications have made significant strides in enhancing the understanding of rural sociology. The research efforts dives deep into various aspects, including the rural economy and livelihoods, rural entrepreneurship, social change, and the modernization of rural communities. The studies also explore education and health in rural areas, as well as rural culture, tradition, environment, sustainability, and gender studies.

The findings from the Ph.D. study on rural-urban interaction and linkages offer a fresh perspective on the dynamics of social change within rural communities. These insights shed light on social mobility and migration, along with their impacts on rural life. Additionally, the results from Journal Articles (JAs) 1, 2, 6, and 25 have played a crucial role in deepening the understanding of the rural economy and how livelihood diversification affects the well-being of rural residents. They provide valuable empirical data on the economic status of rural industries and the potential for income diversification in these areas.

Moreover, the empirical findings from JAs 4, 5, 10, 15, 16, 20, 21, and 24 have broadened body of knowledge about the importance of agricultural extension in promoting sustainable agriculture in rural regions. This is particularly relevant for maintaining farm income in the face of changing climatic conditions, which is essential for fostering sustainable rural development. Findings from JA 12 provided insights into land conflict resolution in rural areas, thereby contributing significantly to the body of knowledge in rural policies and governance.

Additionally, the findings from JAs 13 and 18 shed light on the food consumption habits and waste reduction strategies of rural households, playing a crucial role in ensuring food security for those living in these areas. Likewise, JAs 3, 8, and 9 laid out a practical framework for sustainable vegetable farming, which is a key source of income for rural communities, ultimately enhancing the welfare of the local population. Meanwhile, the research from JAs 19 and 22 added valuable insights into rural poverty and job opportunities. These articles explored how poverty impacts rural families and highlighted the employment prospects for educated young people, driven by both agricultural and non-agricultural activities, aimed at reducing the trend of migration from rural to urban areas.

The findings from JAs 7, 17, and 23 have made a huge impact on the understanding of gender roles, the gaps that exist, and how resources are accessed and used for agricultural production and other income-generating activities. This research lays the groundwork for grasping the basic social structures and dynamics in rural areas. Meanwhile, the insights from JA 11 shed light on key factors that affect the health status of rural populations, particularly women, who are among the most vulnerable groups in these communities. Additionally, JA 14 offers valuable information about rural culture and traditions, especially regarding the local use and trade of wildlife trophies. Dr. Alabi has made quite an impact on Google Scholar, with 320 citations, an h-index of 6, and an i10 index of 5 as of March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Additionally, she has a Research Interest Score of 91.6, with 17 citations and an h-index of 2. Her publications on ResearchGate ([www.researchgate.net](http://www.researchgate.net)) and Google Scholar have significantly boosted the visibility and ranking of UNIOSUN on the web.
