P. SUMMARY OF CONTRIBUTION TO KNOWLEDGE:

- My research has dealt extensively on the collection development practices and procedures adopted in Osun State University Library and other University Libraries in Osun State and suggested ways to improve policies on acquisition of library materials in Academic Libraries. I researched into how important improved information is to Agricultural productivity and Development and the digital divide between Urban and Rural areas in the availability of information and encourage local groups through the help of the government to build their own online access services, this suggested a look into Information Censorship as against the Freedom to freely express one’s ideas to maximally inform a prospective user of such information. Furthermore, my research has

looked into the uses of Library services and materials by Undergraduates in Osun State University, their utilization of available resources and satisfaction derived from such use and made far reaching recommendations. I also investigated the legal rights of the less privileged, specifically the blind to Copyrighted educational materials putting in cognizance the rights to the content's intellectual work by their authors, ways of improvements are suggested. My work has looked at Pharmaceutical Patent rights of drug researchers and sponsors, which was brought vis a vis the rights to access to proper medical care by prospective patients and drug users, this led to a glossary look into the oaths taken by medical practitioners in giving such care and an appraisal of Laws on Medical negligence as well as the advantages of the introduction National Health Insurance Schemes (NHIS) to Citadels of Learning in Nigeria. Article 6 reports the seemingly unrealistic but possible, occurring and recurring act of Male Rape and the need for sanctions and its inclusion under the Nigerian Criminal Jurisprudence.
