P. SUMMARY OF CONTRIBUTION TO KNOWLEDGE:

(Focus: Agribusiness Management, Food Economics, and Agricultural trade)

Dr. Busari has demonstrated sustained scholarly excellence and a clearly defined research trajectory in Agricultural Economics, Rural Development, and Agricultural Systems Analysis, with significant interdisciplinary linkages to food security, climate change adaptation, agricultural value chains, and rural livelihood systems. His body of work reflects consistent intellectual productivity, methodological rigor, and strong policy relevance across Nigeria and comparable developing economies. A major contribution of Dr. Busari lies in advancing knowledge on smallholder agricultural production systems and rural household economics. Through extensive empirical studies on small ruminant production, poultry farming, fish farming, cocoa production, cashew value chains, oil palm processing, and crop-based enterprises, the candidate has generated robust evidence on profitability, efficiency, and productivity determinants in Nigerian agriculture (1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 15, 16, 25, 29, 30, 31, 33, 35, 36, 37, 51, and 52). His research consistently demonstrates that farm-level performance is shaped by access to resources, management practices, market structure, and macroeconomic conditions. These contributions provide an improved empirical foundation for understanding agricultural transformation processes in sub-Saharan Africa.

Dr. Busari has also made significant contributions to food security, livelihood diversification, and rural welfare analysis. His studies have explored poverty status, gender disparities, income diversification, food security dynamics, and household consumption behavior among rural farming communities (9, 21, 26, 26, 43, 44, 48, 49, and 54). These studies collectively highlight the vulnerability of rural households to economic and environmental shocks while emphasizing the role of diversified livelihood strategies in improving resilience. Dr. Busari's findings have informed ongoing debates on inclusive rural development and agricultural-based poverty reduction strategies. In the area of agricultural value chains, trade, and market systems, Dr. Busari has produced influential research on commodity competitiveness, export supply dynamics, and marketing efficiency. His analyses of cocoa, cashew, palm oil, agricultural exports, and fish markets provide critical insights into Nigeria's agricultural trade performance and international competitiveness (25, 30, 31, 33, 35, 36, 37, and 41). These studies employ advanced econometric and policy analysis frameworks, thereby strengthening theoretical understanding of agricultural trade flows and export-led growth in developing economies.

A further key contribution of Dr. Busari's research is in climate change adaptation and environmental sustainability within agricultural systems. His work has examined the effects of climate variability on crop production, water costs, and farmer adaptation strategies, providing evidence of the growing pressures faced by smallholder farmers (22, 42, 44, 50, and 53). He has demonstrated that adaptive capacity is strongly influenced by socio-economic conditions, institutional support, and access to technology, thereby contributing to the development of climate-resilient agricultural policy frameworks. Dr. Busari has also contributed significantly to rural development studies focusing on livelihood systems, migration, gender relations, and non-farm income activities. His research has examined rural-urban migration effects on agricultural productivity, gender disparities in resource access, and livelihood diversification strategies among farming households (12, 19, 21, 26, 28, 44, 48, 49, 56, and 57). These studies provide critical insights into structural transformation processes in rural economies and highlight the importance of inclusive development policies that address gender and social inequality.

In addition, Dr. Busari has advanced knowledge in agricultural efficiency, risk management, and production economics. His work on technical efficiency, risk behavior, pesticide use, and farm management practices demonstrates strong application of quantitative analytical tools to evaluate production systems (11, 24, 27, 39, 43, and 55). These contributions are particularly relevant for improving productivity and decision-making among smallholder farmers in developing economies. Dr. Busari's scholarship also extends into natural resource economics and environmental impact assessment. His studies on quarry activities, land degradation, food waste, and environmental pressures on agriculture highlight the interaction between agricultural systems and environmental sustainability (17, 27, and 38). These works reinforce the importance of sustainable resource use and environmental stewardship in agricultural development planning. Furthermore, the candidate has contributed to institutional and technological dimensions of agriculture, particularly in relation to ICT adoption, digitalization of poultry systems, and extension services (15 and 24). These studies emphasize the role of innovation and technology adoption in modernizing agricultural production systems and improving efficiency across value chains. Collectively, Dr. Busari's research outputs demonstrate a coherent and impactful scholarly agenda focused on improving agricultural productivity, strengthening rural livelihoods, and advancing sustainable agricultural systems. His work integrates microeconomic analysis, policy evaluation, and development theory, thereby bridging the gap between academic research and practical agricultural development challenges.

In summary, the candidate has established himself as a leading scholar in Agricultural Economics whose research has significantly contributed to understanding smallholder agricultural systems, food security dynamics, climate adaptation, and agricultural trade competitiveness. His extensive and consistent publication record, spanning empirical, theoretical, and policy-oriented studies, provides compelling evidence of scholarly maturity and leadership.

Dr. Busari is currently working on regional interlinkages of agricultural trade in the West Africa sub-region, Production, and value addition of agricultural export commodities, and the linkages between public expenditure and improved agricultural export earnings in Nigeria for the much-needed economic diversification. Also, he is on Google Scholar with citations of 255, an h-index: of 8, and, an i10 index: of 7 as of July, 6th, 2026, and a Research interest score of 280.4, 176 citations, and an h-index of 7.
