Research Focus:

My research centres on **Transportation Planning and Urban Management**, with a particular emphasis on the interplay between mobility systems, infrastructure provision, and sustainable urban development. Through extensive studies on **road**

traffic accidents, noise pollution, speed breakers, and informal roadside trading, I have highlighted how deficiencies in transport planning contribute to safety risks and inefficiencies in Nigerian cities. My work also investigates the **governance of educational and urban infrastructure**, the spatial distribution of facilities, and the role of public policy in shaping accessibility and equity within rapidly urbanizing environments.

In addition, my publications explore **environmental management and land use dynamics**, including urban agriculture, sanitation practices, and waste generation in markets, thereby linking transport systems to broader urban sustainability challenges. By combining **geospatial analysis, infrastructure assessment, and stakeholder engagement**, my research provides actionable insights for improving transportation safety, enhancing urban governance, and fostering resilient, livable settlements in Nigeria and comparable developing contexts.

P. SUMMARY OF CONTRIBUTION TO KNOWLEDGE:

I have made modest contributions to knowledge in the field of Urban and Regional Planning especially in Transportation Planning and Urban Management, with twenty-one (21) publications.

My contributions to knowledge in Transportation Planning can be found in my Ph.D. thesis and ten (10) published articles dealing with road transportation and the safety of people. The papers analysed the road traffic environment, the use and management of transportation infrastructure and the consequences of its neglect in terms of road traffic accidents, and the effectiveness of road traffic safety measures. The papers explored the safety awareness of road users, especially the informal roadside traders and their impacts on the road environment.

In the area of urban management, eleven (11) publications examined the development control activities of planning authorities with respect to healthy living and urban waste management in conjunction with the roles of stakeholders in environmental management. The papers discovered the dysfunctionality and ineffectiveness of public agencies in carrying out their roles and responsibilities of ensuring a functional, healthy and aesthetically liveable human environment.

These studies have made contributions to knowledge in providing viable solutions to road transportation challenges, environmental management problems and quality of life issues in the human environment. The studies were embarked upon in urban and rural areas of Nigeria, a rapidly urbanizing country, which makes them relevant to emerging trends in sustainable development.
